- where it will be (inside your house, in your garden or on the pavement outside.) If you can get it to the pavement it would be very helpful.
- If it is inside your house there will have to be someone home as we cannot guarantee timings of collections.
- Please bag any dirty items.

There will be volunteers from the Community Church helping with the collection throughout the morning. But they would like our help.
